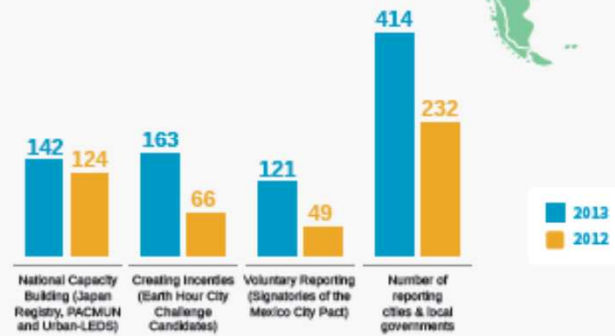

Nantes Declaration of Mayors and Subnational Leaders on Climate Change Local Government Climate Roadmap 2013-2015



As of October 2013, 414 cities and local governments, with a population of 438 million people in 45 countries, reported 836 climate and energy commitments, 4,208 mitigation and adaptation actions and 770 greenhouse gas inventories covering municipal operations and community activities that aggregate to an annual GHG emissions of 2.2 Giga tons of CO₂ equivalent.

Preamble + 20 action points for raising pre2020 ambition



- **Response to Global processes**

- rapid transformation, know-how of local governments, ambitious Paris outcome, post2015 development agenda

- **Renewed climate advocacy strategy**

- Governmental stakeholders, Friends of Cities, Ministerial-Mayoral dialogues, action plan by Paris 2015

- **Financing to scale-up local climate action**

- Municipal budgets, transparency/accountability, multilevel governance models, financing windows for holistic urban development, new and innovative mechanisms, vertical integration, phase-out fossils

- **Preparation of a technical paper by SB40,**
- **Expanding Ministerial-Mayoral dialogues to Ministers of Urbanization/Housing**
- **Facilitation of a 2016-2026 Action Plan for a Decade of Urban Low Emissions Development as a part of Paris 2015 Outcome**

4. Also **resolves to enhance action and raise ambition** significantly in the 2014–2020 period, including by:

f. **Welcoming and encouraging activities** to identify and implement adaptation and mitigation actions, including through cooperative initiatives, at the national and multilateral levels and **by subnational and local governments and** non-State actors;

5. **Decides to launch the following specific activities** in the context of an action agenda:

b. The **organization of a forum to identify key priority areas** for collaborative work on mitigation and adaptation **at the sub-national level**, to be convened in conjunction with the session of the Ad Hoc Working Group on the Durban Platform for Enhanced Action that is **held concurrently** with the fortieth sessions of the subsidiary bodies **(June 2014)**;
